2). Montrose TIRZ Update – The Montrose TIRZ status and support was presented by Gene Creely and Greg L

Key Items discussed were:

- Neartown Super Neighborhood unanimous Neartown member neighborhood associations support for a Montrose TIRZ given the choice of Montrose being annexed by an existing TIRZ, a Montrose TIRZ and no Montrose TIRZ.
- The formal documentation of a Montrose TIRZ having been presented to City Council Cohen and the Mayor's staff.
- The Montrose TIRZ encomposes the major theorfares with the Boundaries of Montrose that will interconnect to surrounding areas allowing a benefit to all.
- Specific select commercial properties were included within the TIRA boundary that are undergoing current or planned major development. This results in a high dollar initial TIRZ dollar increment. This incremental tax amount will go unrealized with the current tax ceiling in effect.
