

## 1. Introductions

2. Avondale Promenade Project (aka 424 Westheimer) is moving forward − Duncan Elliott the Project Manager with COH Parks Projects and Jim Patterson with White Oak Studios Landscape Architecture → Duncan and Jim went over the timing, funding and unique attributes of the soon to be Avondale Promenade Park at 424 Westheimer. Items of interest were:

The 9,988 sf park land was acquired by HPARD. Texas Parks Department granted the \$1,000,000 cost of building the park and is currently reviewing the final stages of the park design. The park is being built to blend with the architectural history of the Avondale neighborhood. Proposed elements include a promenade to connect park users to shade structures with swinging benches, home for Remembrance Garden Markers, a Chimney Swift Tower, a play area, and a dog run. Bidding for the park build will be by mid-2019 with the park opening in early 2020.



## 3. <u>Other –</u>

- Walkable Places Committee Transit Corridor Changes → Greg discussed items of concern on Proposed Transit Corridor Performance Standards, with optional compliance standards being proposed as required. In particular, market based parking in Type A Corridor areas and the expansion of Type A corridor streets. The City of Houston Planning Department is doing a site specific Transit Corridor and associated Type A streets analysis of the future[?] Montrose/ Neartown Station on Richmond and plans to attend Neartown's January 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting to address changes and concerns.
